1st Teaching period (50 minutes)

1st Activity

Time: 15'

Type of activity: video projection, debate

Class organisation: whole class

Actions/Tasks: In order to make students aware of the effects of their daily habits on the environment, the teacher presents them a video about the ecological footprint. After watching the video, the teacher discusses with the students how they think it could reduce their own ecological footprint.

2nd Activity

Time: 5'

Type of activity: play game

Class organisation: whole class

Actions/Tasks: In order to make students aware of how much they pollute, the teacher invites them to calculate their own ecological footprint with the help of an application.

3rd Activity

Time: 30'

Type of activity: brainstorming, powerpointpresentation

Class organisation: individual work

Actions/Tasks: The teacher gives students a powerpoint about pollution and its consequences. After acquiring the new information, students will answer an H5P questionnaire on the same topic.

2nd Teaching period (50 minutes)

1st Activity

Time: 20'

Type of activity: team work, artistic creation

Class organisation: pairs

Actions/Tasks: The teacher divides the students into 4 groups and asks them to draw some anti-pollution slogans that they will spread in the school.

2nd Activity Time: 30'

Type of activity: brainstorming

Class organisation: whole class

Actions: The teacher challenges the students to solve math problems (Worksheet 1), in which elements about combating pollution appear.
