INTERNATIONAL TREATIES GOVERNING THE DEFENSE OF THE RIGHTS OF CHILDREN

United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child.

This document was adopted on 20 November 1989 by the United Nations on 20 November 1989. It has been ratified by all the member states of the United Nations. Romania adopted the act on September 20, 1990.

November 20 was declared the International Day of the Rights of the Child

- Declaration of the Rights of the Child issued by UNICEF on November 20, 1959

- The Treaty of Lisbon

In particular, Article 3 (3) of the Treaty on European Union explicitly obliges the EU to promote the protection of the rights of the child.

- European Convention on the Exercise of Children's Rights

The Convention aims to protect the best interests of children. The Convention provides for measures which aim to promote the rights of the children, in particular in family proceedings before judicial authorities.
