1st teaching period

1st Activity: Introduction

<u>Time</u>: 10' <u>Type of activity</u>: initial activity

<u>Class organisation</u>: class work

<u>Actions/Tasks</u>: Teacher explains what the goal of these sessions is: to learn the basic tools of a word processor (LibreOffice) by learning basic concepts from the European Union. LibreOffice is a free and open-source office productivity software. It was forked in 2010 from <u>OpenOffice.org</u>, an open-sourced version of the earlier <u>StarOffice</u>. The LibreOffice suite consists of programs for word processing, creating and editing of spreadsheets, slideshows, diagrams and drawings, working with databases, and composing mathematical formulae. It is available in 115 languages. LibreOffice uses the OpenDocument standard as its native file format, but supports formats of most other major office suites, including Microsoft Office, through a variety of import and export filters. LibreOffice is available for a variety of computing platforms, with official support for Microsoft Windows, macOS and Linux.

It is advisable for all students to have the same word processor installed, LibreOffice can be freely downloaded from the official page: <u>https://www.libreoffice.org/download/download/</u>

2nd Activity: Save a document

<u>Time</u>: 10' <u>Type of activity</u>: save a document <u>Class organisation</u>: individual work <u>Actions/Tasks</u>: Task1, part I: save a document. Sudents open the word processor and save a document to see how it is done

3rd Activity: Paste a text

<u>Time</u>: 15' <u>Type of activity</u>: reading activity and copy-paste functions <u>Class organisation</u>: individual work <u>Actions/Tasks</u>: Students read the text detailing the values on which the European Union is founded and then select and paste the text following instructions (task1, part II).

4th Activity: Export as pdf

<u>Time</u>: 10' <u>Type of activity</u>: export as pdf <u>Class organisation</u>: individual work <u>Actions/Tasks:</u> in this part of the task, a copy of the document will be made in pdf format (part III) and the document and the application will be closed (part IV and V).

5th Activity: European Union values

<u>Time</u>: 15' <u>Type of activity</u>: reflection activity <u>Class organisation</u>: class work <u>Actions/Tasks</u>: Once the task has been completed, it is time for teacher with all class or in small groups to give some thought to the values on which the European Union is based and

which students have read in the text.

2nd teaching period

1st Activity: Modify a document_reading

<u>Time</u>: 10' <u>Type of activity</u>: reading <u>Class organisation</u>: pair work <u>Actions/Tasks</u>: Students read instructions about different functions to modify text in pairs. In this way doubts can be resolved between them.

2nd Activity: Modify a document

<u>Time</u>: 10' <u>Type of activity</u>: exploring functions <u>Class organisation</u>: individual work <u>Actions/Tasks:</u> Students do activity_02 and share de final pdf document to the teacher.

3rd Activity: Symbols from EU and euro information

<u>Time</u>: 10' <u>Type of activity</u>: speaking <u>Class organisation</u>: group work <u>Actions/Tasks:</u> In small groups, students share the information they have been working on (symbols of the European Union and information about the euro). It is important that they share what surprised them, what they knew and what they did not,..

4th Activity: Copy and paste

<u>Time</u>: 15' <u>Type of activity</u>: copy and paste activity <u>Class organisation</u>: individual work <u>Actions/Tasks:</u> Students do activity A and B about copy and paste functions.

5th Activity: New strategic agenda of EU

<u>Time</u>: 10' <u>Type of activity</u>: reflections activity <u>Class organisation</u>: class work

<u>Actions/Tasks:</u> It is important that teacher gives a space to comment on the text "A new strategic agenda for the EU" that students have ordered. It can be read together and

comment on the points.

6th Activity: Drag and drop

<u>Time</u>: 5' <u>Type of activity</u>: homework <u>Class organisation</u>: individual work <u>Actions/Tasks</u>: Students do activity C at home, export activity_03 as pdf document and send to the teacher.

3rd teaching period

1st Activity: Page setup_reading

<u>Time</u>: 10' <u>Type of activity</u>: reading <u>Class organisation</u>: pair work <u>Actions/Tasks</u>: Students read instructions about different functions to page setup in pairs. In this way doubts can be resolved between them.

2nd Activity: Page setup

<u>Time</u>: 10' <u>Type of activity</u>: exploring functions <u>Class organisation</u>: individual work <u>Actions/Tasks</u>: Students do activity_04 and share de final pdf document to the teacher.

3rd Activity: European parliament

<u>Time</u>: 10' <u>Type of activity</u>: speaking <u>Class organisation</u>: group work <u>Actions/Tasks</u>: In small groups, students read the text about European Parliament. It is important that they share what surprised them, what they knew and what they did not,..

4th Activity: Tables_reading

<u>Type of activity</u>: reading <u>Class organisation</u>: pair work <u>Actions/Tasks</u>: Students read instructions about how to prepare tables in pairs. In this way doubts can be resolved between them.

5th Activity: EU countries_introduction

<u>Time</u>: 10' <u>Type of activity</u>: introduction activity <u>Class organisation</u>: class work <u>Actions/Tasks:</u> Teacher distributes the different countries of the European Union between students, individually or by pairs, so that they can search for the information needed to build the table on the next day.

4th teaching period

1st Activity: Tables

<u>Time</u>: 15' <u>Type of activity</u>: prepare a table <u>Class organisation</u>: individually or pair work <u>Actions/Tasks</u>: Students finish activity_05 by preparing the table with information from the European Union country that has been assigned to them.

2nd Activity: Portfolio_reading

<u>Time</u>: 10' <u>Type of activity</u>: reading <u>Class organisation</u>: pair work <u>Actions/Tasks</u>: Students read instructions about how to prepare a portfolio in pairs. In this way doubts can be resolved between them.

3rd Activity: Final activity

<u>Time</u>: 25' <u>Type of activity</u>: prepare the final portfolio <u>Class organisation</u>: individually work <u>Actions/Tasks</u>: Following the assignment instructions, each student prepares the final portfolio including all activities performed in the previous days.

4th Activity: EU revision

<u>Time</u>: 10' <u>Type of activity</u>: revision <u>Class organisation</u>: class work

<u>Actions/Tasks</u>: During all activities, different explanatory texts about the European Union have been analysed. As a final activity, it is important that teacher can review the whole treaty with the students.
