Mohammed was born around 570 in the city of Mecca. He soon became orphan and lived with his grandfather first, then with an uncle. He worked with camels and sheep.

That creature told him about an ancient beduin god (Allah), who created the world, who knows everything and can everything. Since then, Mohammed established the principles of a new monotheistic religion.

When he was 40 years old, he went up the mount Hira and he found there a holy creature, identified as the angel Gabriel.

Rich people and priests were becoming more and more hostile to the new religion, so that Mohammed needed to move in years 622 to the city of Medina (*egira*).

When he was about 25 years old, he married Khadiga, a rich widow. He could administrate her finances and travel a lot for trading purpose all over Arabian peninsula.

During the next two years, Mohammed and his new religion reached the Byzantine Empire borders until Mohammed's death, which occurs in 632.
